I. THE CONSIDERATION OF GOD'S FERVENCY

- A. The Definition of God's Fervency ... The Fervency of God is expressed in a two-fold manner God is both Jealous and Zealous
 - 1. EXAMINATION OF THE WORDS
 - * (qana) to be zealous; jealousy; envy; covet

- * To earnestly desire something/someone in a protective sense
- * ζηλόω (zaelo-o) to be hot or fervent toward; zealous; jealous; envious; covetous
- * Jealousy having a zeal to protect what is precious to you
- 2. EXAMPLES OF THE WORD USAGE (Jealous: Joseph's brothers; Korah; Jewish leaders; Zealous: Phinehas; Elijah
- B. The Display of God's Fervency
 - 1. THE FERVENCY OF GOD IS DISPLAYED IN HIS ZEAL ... For His Person, His Plan and His People
 - 2. THE FERVENCY OF GOD IS DISPLAYED IN HIS JEALOUSY FOR HIS CHILDREN'S AFFECTIONS ... He will not share us with another!

1. FOR HIS P (cf. Prov 23:17; Numbers 25: 10-13) We need to be careful of our motives b/c this zeal can become misguided (Rom 10:2; Acts 22:3; Gal 1:14; Phil 3:6
2. FOR HIS P (cf. John 2:17; Matthew 6:33) We need to be careful of our motives b/c this zeal can become misguided (James 3:13-16)
3. FOR HIS P (cf. Romans 12:10-11; II Corinthians 11:2) We need to be careful of our motives b/c this zeal can become misguided (Galatians 4:17-18)
