

INTRODUCTION

- * We have been considering the subject of Knowing God - the most satisfying and stimulating relationship that you will ever have; knowing God is the source of eternal life
- * We first considered the existence and exclusiveness of God - that He is God and God alone.
- * We then considered the composition of God - the tri-unity of God: that within the one Godhead there is three distinct personalities: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit
- * We have then transitioned into the attributes of God, considering first His natural attributes - those attributes of God that are His based on the fact that He is God
- * Over the past two weeks we considered the Sovereignty of God - that as God He reigns supremely over the nations, creation, affairs and salvation of man.
- * Today, we want to consider four more of those natural attributes that are all tied together into a larger concept: the Limitlessness of God
 - The Limitlessness of God refers to the fact that God is unbounded His own creation.
 - This can be broken into two categories: the spheres of God's limitlessness and the derivatives of God's limitlessness.
