

INTRODUCTION

- * We have been considering the subject of Knowing God - the most satisfying and stimulating relationship that you will ever have; knowing God is the source of eternal life
- * We first considered the existence and exclusiveness of God - that He is God and God alone.
- * We then considered the composition of God - the tri-unity of God:
 - that within the one Godhead there is three distinct personalities: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit
- * We have then transitioned into the attributes of God,
 - considering first His natural attributes - those attributes of God that are His based on the fact that He is God
 - We have considered His Sovereignty and His Limitlessness - that He is Eternal, Infinite, Omniscient and Omnipresent.
- * Today, we want finish out the natural attributes by considering that attribute which ties together the natural attributes - that is the omnipotence of God ...

- * SINCE GOD IS ETERNAL AND INFINITE, SO IS HIS POWER
(cf. Psalm 62: 11; Romans 1: 20; Job 42: 1-2; Genesis 18:13-14; Matthew 19: 23-26; Jeremiah 32: 17-19)
- * "ALMIGHTY" is used 57 times in the Scripture ... all as a direct reference to God
 - Hebrew: **שָׁדַי** (Shaddai - all powerful) ... is only used of God!
(cf. Genesis 17: 1; Exodus 6: 2-3; Job 5: 17; Joel 1:15)
 - Greek: **παντοκράτωρ** (pantkatorē - all strength/might/power) ... is only used of God
(cf. Revelation 1:8; 11: 16-17; 15:2-3; 19:6)
