- * FOCUSING ON THE CHRIST ... The Shadow of Christ, The Life of Christ, The Return of Christ, The Reign of Christ ... The Reflection of Christ
- * What we say, and how we live, is a reflection of Who, or what, is residing and reigning in our heart!
- * We saw this as we examined the Individual Reflection as seen in: Our Speech (Lk 6:43-46); Finances (Mt 6:19-24) & Relationships (Eph 5:32-6:9)
- * A few weeks ago we began considering the collective reflection of the church by examining the illustrations that Scripture uses of the relationship of the church to Christ first, considering the church as the Building, then as the Bride.
- * Today, we would like to consider the church as the Body of Christ.
- * Church Growth is a very hot topic. How do we get the church to grow? Many churches seek to use programs, music and such to entice people to come to their assembly. But what does the Bible teach about church growth? If I asked how many would like to see our church grow, I would expect that almost every person would give their affirmation. But are we, Biblically doing "what it takes" for a church to grow?
