- * Paul's letter to the Romans
- * We have just completed the "doctrinal" foundation of Paul's letter, the discussion of salvation by faith alone leading up to the presentation of God's plan for Israel
- * Paul unveiled the mystery of God: that Israel, because of their disobedience, would be set aside for a period of time (in which God would open up salvation to the Gentiles as a means of provocation to the Jews to make them jealous such that they would return to God by faith) and at the end of this period of time all Israel would be delivered.
- * Today, we pick up Paul's discourse with his transition into what effect the revelation of this mystery should have upon the body of Christ beginning first with the individual believer.
