- \* This change in the relationship was caused by Saul's pride and jealousy
- \* Chapter 18 ends with two poignant remarks, "Saul became David's enemy continually" and "David behaved more wisely than all the servants of Saul, so that his name became highly esteemed."
- <sup>\*</sup> How do we, or should we, respond in the midst of this type of hostile situation? Where is God in all of this?
- \* Today, we will continue to see the blessing of God upon those who have been "called according to His purpose" ... to those He has anointed.
