INTRODUCTION

- * Teaching through the Bible in 7 years
- * We have just completed looking at Joshua, Judges and Ruth considering Israel's entry into the promised land and their initial years in the land as they were ruled by various Judges.
- * Lord willing, we will spend the next year continuing our examination of Israel's history in the promised land. God's Word declares that these things were written for our learning (Rom 15:4). Let us seek to apply our heart to understanding (Prov 2:3-6) the wisdom that God has for us!
- * The book of 1 Samuel is a transitional book. It begins in the time of the Judges and leads us into the reign of David.
- * The three primary characters of this book are: Samuel, Saul and David.
- * As the book of Judges was summarized by two key passages (2:8,10 and 21:25), so the remainder of Israel's history can be prefaced with Israel's statement recorded in 8:19-20 "No, but we will have a king over us, that we also may be like all the nations"
- Today, we begin this next phase of Israel's history by considering the birth of the last judge: Samuel.
