INTRODUCTION

- * The book of 1 Samuel is a transitional book. It begins in the time of the Judges and leads us into the reign of David.
- * The three primary characters of this book are: Samuel, Saul and David.
- * As the book of Judges was summarized by two key passages (2:8,10 and 21:25), so the remainder of Israel's history can be prefaced with Israel's statement recorded in 8:19-20 "No, but we will have a king over us, that we also may be like all the nations"
- * We have considered the birth of Samuel (in the midst of Hannah's prayer and praise) and the call of Samuel (in the midst of Eli's punishment).
- * Over the past two weeks we considered the loss of the Ark of the Covenant as a result of the chastisement of Eli & his sons and the affliction that the LORD invoked upon the Philistines to reveal His sovereignty to them.
- * We concluded last week's message by considering God's sovereign control of the cattle and cart which brought the Ark of the Covenant back to Israel.
- * Today, we pick up the story with the reception of the Ark by the men of Beth-Shemesh. As well, we revisit the cycle of the judges: Sin (Eli & Sons) ... Chastisement (Philistines) ... Repentance ... Deliverer ... Peace
