INTRODUCTION

- Recently in our examination of the Word of God, we have been considering the reign of David the man after God's own heart.
- After God made an everlasting covenant with David, David fell into sin. He committed adultery with Bathsheba and then orchestrated the death of her
- As a consequence of his sin, the child who was conceived via that illicit relationship would die. Also, God tells David that the sword would not depart from his family and that his own wives would be violated - only publicly.
- Today, we begin to see more of the ripple effects of David's sin. We would do well to consider its application to our own lives!
