INTRODUCTION

- * "Focusing on the Messiah in the book of Matthew." Matthew was a Jewish man writing to a Jewish audience and giving testimony regarding the life and ministry of the Messiah who had been foretold by many of the Jewish prophets.
- * Today, we continue our examination of the extension of His ministry.
- * Last week we saw the compassion of the Messiah for the motley mass of people (multitudes) that had gathered to Him they were as sheep without a shepherd. With that compassion, He then commissioned His disciples to represent Him and the Kingdom throughout Israel.
