INTRODUCTION

- * Paul's first epistle (letter) to the church of Corinth was written in order to assist them in dealing with various issues with which they were struggling.
- Living in a hedonistic, licentious society can have an affect upon the "set-apartness" of the individual believer and gathering of believers.
 Paul has just spent a great portion of his epistle discussing the subject of Christian Liberty and culminated it with the commands to glorify God in
- everything we do and to not give an offense to others which could hinder them from coming to Christ, or drawing closer to Him. * Paul transitions further into the considerations of surrendering our "rights" while seeking the glory of God and edification of others by examining
- three separate subject areas: Headship, Communion and Spiritual Gifts.
- In this discussion of Headship we see again the conflicting influences of the Jewish and Grecian cultural backgrounds of these new believers.

- * THEREFORE, WHATEVER YOU DO ... DO ALL TO THE GLORY OF GOD!
- * IS THERE A NEED TO "CHANGE THE WAY YOU THINK" ... AND, THEREFORE, ACT?
