INTRODUCTION

- * Living in a hedonistic, licentious society can have an affect upon the "set-apartness" of the individual believer and gathering of believers.
- * Paul reveals that this "set-apartness" applies to worship practices as well. Jesus stated, "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." (John 4:23-24)
- * THE BASIS OF THIS TEACHING:
 - **The Ignorance of the Corinthians** ... Paul's introduction to this subject is to remind the brethren of their need to gain of true spiritual knowledge and understanding.
 - The Improper Foundation of the Corinthians ... Being led away (apago) you were brought/led (ago) to voiceless idols! (The majority of the 16 uses of apago refer to Jesus being forcibly led away). Their thinking was contaminated by false religious practices which they gullibly were led into by demonic influences (cf. 10:20). Hence, they needed to "change the way they think."
