TEXT: 1 Corinthians 12:31 - 13:13

INTRODUCTION

- Living in a hedonistic, licentious society can have an affect upon the "set-apartness" of the individual believer and the gathering of believers. *
- Last week, we began looking at how this set-apartness applies to our worship practices as well.
- We noted that Jesus stated, "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth." (John 4:23-24)
- * In v. 1&2 we saw that the Basis of the Teaching on Spiritual Gifts was the Corinthians' Ignorance and Improper Spiritual Foundation. Their thinking was contaminated by false religious practices which they had been gullibly led into by demonic influences (cf. 10:20).
- Paul explained that every member of the body of Christ is bestowed with a gift (by the Spirit) which they are to minister (by the Son) in the activity assigned (by the Father) ... to benefit the whole body!
- The Corinthians had been focused on themselves and their glory. However, as their lives are to be lived to the glory of God, so their ministry is too. * *
- Paul now builds his case for the selfless exercise of these gifts by teaching them about the Superiority of Selfless Love.
