TEXT: Matthew 8:28-9:13 **INTRODUCTION**

- * We have been "Focusing on the Messiah in the book of Matthew." Matthew was a Jewish man writing to a Jewish audience and giving testimony regarding the life and ministry of the Messiah who had been foretold by many of the Jewish prophets.
- * Matthew has been declaring how Jesus of Nazareth met all of the requirements of messianic prophecies: His lineage, His birth, and His forerunner.
- * As we considered the message of the Messiah, we saw that the people were astonished because Jesus "taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes."
- * All authority intrinsically is backed by some power. Behind the "exousia" (authority) there has to be some "dunamos" (power).
- * Last week we began to consider the proof of the messianic authority of Jesus as it was revealed in His power the physical and spiritual realms.
- * Today, Lord willing, we will be considering the display of Jesus' authority over demons and sin.
