- \* In our study of Matthew's account of the earthly life of the Messiah, we have come to what would have appeared to be the end of Jesus' earthly ministry – His Death by Crucifixion. Fortunately, for us, we are looking backwards and we know that this is NOT a sorrowful ending but rather a crucial step in the Ultimate Victory!
- \* As Jesus has reminded the disciples – and the leaders of the people – continually what was happening was not a random coincidence but rather the Purpose and Plan of God were coming to their fullest fruition at this moment of history.
- \* Today's message is not just about suffering and death ... but even more so about faithfulness and victory!
