INTRODUCTION

- * Over the past couple of weeks, we have been considering the final hours of Christ's earthly ministry from His example of humility in washing the disciples' feet to His sacrificial gift of Himself upon the cross for the sins of the world.
- * The final message of Jesus upon the cross was "It is Finished!" In the Greek, that was the word "tetelestai." It is in the perfect tense, indicating a past action with a continuing result. Jesus stated that in His sacrifice, He was completing all that needed to be accomplished in order for the penalty of our sins to be paid.
- * Today, we examine the confirmation of that sacrificial offering; the attestation that God had truly accepted that offering: His Resurrection!
- * We will examine first of the initial impact of this event upon the lives of some principal participants and then the importance of the Resurrection itself upon mankind.
