INTRODUCTION

- * Based upon the greatness of their calling, believers are challenged to "Walk worthy of the calling with which [they] were called."
- * We have seen Paul's challenge for them to "Walk worthy" in the body of Christ seeking unity and synergy in the body of Christ; and in the world living transformed and sanctified lives. We are no longer to think like the Gentiles think; we are no longer to act like the Gentiles act. Rather, we are to have the mind of Christ and put on the new man which is created by God in true righteousness and holiness.
- * Last week, we began to consider how we are to "Walk Worthy" within three specific relationships that we have in this world: marital, parental, and occupational relationships. We saw that in our marital relationships, we are to model the relationship that Christ has with the Church.
- * Today, we will consider how can "Walk Worthy" in our parental and occupational relationships.
