INTRODUCTION

- * In our study of the Biblical history of Israel we have been considering that history which is specific to the Northern Kingdom (Israel).
- * On March 9th, we transitioned into the testimony regarding the house of Omri and chiefly, King Ahab ... along with the ministry of Elijah.
- * In that message we noted the testimony of the reign of Ahab: "Now Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD, more than all who were before him. And it came to pass, as though it had been a trivial thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took as wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal, king of the Sidonians; and he went and served Baal and worshiped him. Then he set up an altar for Baal in the temple of Baal, which he had built in Samaria. And Ahab made a wooden image. Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel who were before him." (1 Kings 16:30-33)
- * During the subsequent weeks, we considered the interaction of YHWH with Israel via his prophet Elijah.
- Last week, we saw God's faithfulness in His protection of Northern Israel from the invasion of Ben-Hadad (of Syria). During that consideration we noted how many times God had been graciously seeking to reveal Himself to Ahab ... "that you shall know that I am YHWH." Yet, Ahab continually rebuffs those attempts.
- * Today, we will study one of the most infamous events recorded regarding Ahab and Jezebel that regarding the "acquisition" of Naboth's vineyard.
