## INTRODUCTION

- We have turned in our study of the Biblical history of Israel to an examination of the kings of the South.
- Over the past three weeks, we have seen the importance of the influence of the kings (leaders) upon their nations. Chuck and Steve considered the revival and restoration influence of Asa and Jehoshaphat.
