## INTRODUCTION

- Three weeks ago we began studying "The Gospel According to Luke." Luke's desire was to present an orderly account of the ministry of Jesus the Christ in order that those who heard could be assured of the verity of the testimony they had heard.
- Two weeks ago, we saw that Luke began his orderly account with the Angelic Announcement to Zacharias regarding the birth of John. Zacharias needed a "sign" to truly believe the message that Gabriel was proclaiming to him. Therefore, Gabriel declared that Zacharias would be mute for the next nine months, until the birth of his son.
